Integrated Math II Syllabus

Dear Parents/Guardians and Students:

INTRODUCTION: Math II is a college preparatory year long course that covers algebra, geometry, and probability units.

TESTS/NOTEBOOKS: Assessments will include quizzes and tests on Edgenuity as well as in class assessments during block time. This allows me, as an instructor, to accurately gauge students' understanding of the content area. Semester examinations will be the final Edgenuity module and will be taken on campus during the last week of the semester. A single subject spiral notebook, written in the specified format, is **required** of each student. Students are expected to **take Cornell style notes** on each Edgenuity lesson **within** each Module. A **successful** student may expect to spend a **minimum** of 5 hours per week working in the Edgenuity program.

MATH LABS: Attendance at math lab is highly recommended for success in this course. **There is a math lab on Wednesday morning from 9am-10am just for Integrated Math II students in the Adult Ed room.** This is the best time to get specific Math II help. In addition, there are general math labs as follows:

Tuesday from 2-4 pm, Wednesday from 10-11am and 3-4:30pm, and Thursday from 3-4:30pm

Please note: as there are no math labs available on Friday, it is important for students to plan ahead on Fridays that modules are due, and be sure that they have all major questions answered during a math lab earlier in the week.

STUDENT EVALUATION: Letter grades are based upon points obtained from Edgenuity (50% on-line coursework and 20% spiral notebook) and work done during block time (20% activities and 10% in class assessments). Parents and students may check grades at any time via <https://aeries.redlandsusd.net/ParentPortal/LoginParent.aspx> (link also available on eAcademy Website)

CLASS RULES: The class will follow rules established by the eAcademy Attendance and Discipline Policy. Tardies and absences may affect a student's grade due to the student missing class participation and information discussed. Any student that cheats or allows another student to cheat from his or her work will receive a "0" for the assignment.

MODULES: There will be 6 modules for Integrated Math II 1st semester with the following start and end dates. All modules will be closed at 3pm on the indicated Fridays and the new module opened at that time.

- Module 1 - 8/10-8/26
- Module 2 – 8/26-9/23
- Module 3 - 9/23-10/14
- Module 4 - 10/14-11/4
- Module 5 -11/4-11/25
- Module 6 - 11/25-12/9
- Module 7 – 12/9-12/15

Modules may be reopened after the deadline, but will incur a 10% deduction in the overall grade for that Module. In addition, the incomplete module will only be reopened if the current module is up to date and the student is on campus working with a math instructor or attending Eagles' Nest.

LATE WORK: Notebooks are due in class on the first block day after the Module closes. If a student does not turn his or her notebook in on time, he or she will also receive a 10% deduction on the points available.
