

Welcome to eAcademy Earth & Space Science A (1st Semester)

This is a blended Edgenuity course which means that you will do work on the computer and off the computer at home and on campus. The majority of your coursework (70% of your final grade) is completed on the Edgenuity program within the assigned module time frame. The blended portion of the coursework (30%) consists of classroom work: Labs, note taking from Edgenuity lessons and journal responses are examples of some of this content..
